## Tai Tham MY Keyboard Map

The Tai Tham MY keyboard was developed for typing Tai Lue language in Tai Tham script. The keyboard is available for computers as well as mobile devices.

## **Keyboard for Computer**

There are 3 parts to the keyboard map: "Normal" part; "Shift" part and "Right Alt" part. The Normal part is shown below. To type the character you want, press the appropriate key.
